Did you know that 50 percent of child fire deaths affect children under the age of 5? Escaping from a fire can be difficult for very young children because they generally lack the motor skills and mental capabilities needed to quickly escape a burning building. Additionally, some children are unable to awake from a deep sleep when a smoke alarm sounds.

Protect your most precious assets... install and maintain smoke alarms and residential sprinklers and practice home fire escape plans to ensure your children will be safe if a fire were to start in your home.
